PANORAMIC FIREPLACE IN TENUTA POLVARO

Tenuta Polvaro's history, in Annone Veneto, is connected to that of the Serenissima Republic of Venice, which from 1420 became the owner of the immense forest of oaks and ash trees that covered the territory from which it drew valuable timber destined for the arsenal.

Part of this land was later acquired by the noble Venetian Polvaro family. Around 1681 the aristocratic Polvaro family cleared and made cultivable the land where the Tenuta stands, and built the manor house and adjoining barchesse including a private chapel.



In 2009, the De Zan Candoni family purchased Tenuta Polvaro with the aim of restoring this wonderful property to its former glory while fully respecting the canons of 17th-century architecture.

The vineyards are also the subject of a gradual restructuring project that aims first and foremost to preserve the estate's wine-growing heritage. Of particular importance in this restructuring operation is respect for the environment and landscaping.

With a careful renovation today Tenuta Polvaro is also a prestigious Location for Events, it offers cozy rooms suitable for small events and intimate weddings in which to be embraced by the warmth of wood-burning fireplaces and large halls and verandas for great parties, dinners and meetings of various kinds.



The UPPSALA fireplace, from the PANORAMIC range, installed in one of TENUTA POLVARO's living rooms, is a fireplace with a striking visual impact and thanks to its technology, it ensures optimal combustion with reduced emissions for a low environmental impact. It is the perfect combination of technological innovation, sophisticated design, fireplace and handcrafted majolica tradition.

Chosen to make this particular corner of Tenuta Polvaro cozy and warm, UPPSALA naturally becomes the beating center of the room, around which you can sit, sharing the excitement of crackling wood and enjoying the pleasant warmth of the fire. The view of the flame is particularly

beautiful and evocative embraced by the 360-degree panoramic glass without any metal profile. The vertically sliding panoramic glass, which folds away completely into the base, is motor-driven with button controls.

Among the distinctive features are the large black steel hood and the base clad with precious large hand-crafted Majolica panels surrounding the firebox.

Majolica panels with these shapes and large surfaces are the result of handed down professional experience that is distinctive to Piazzetta. The production of Majolica cladding requires time and expertise: the entire production cycle takes 12 to 15 days to complete, with a dozen specialized workers involved in the process.
